### Cruising in France

#### CRUISE ITINERARIES

'Enchanté' cruises the Canal du Midi between Puichèric and Sallèles-d'Aude. She also cruises in Provence and the Camargue between Béziers and Bellegarde, on a route that is half canal and half lake/river. Itineraries with special themes — such as cycling, family, walking and wine appreciation — can be arranged for chartering parties with special interests.

All cruises are from Sunday through Saturday (six nights), with longer options available for chartering parties.

#### ON-BOARD ACCOMMODATIONS

The four cabins are 165 square feet each, including an en suite bathroom. Beds can be configured as either doubles or twins and are nearly 6.5 feet long. Electrical current is 220V (standard European). Each cabin has an en suite bathroom with soap, shampoo/shower gel, and a hairdryer provided for guests' use. There is also a mobile phone in each cabin for guests' use during the cruise with € 5 credit included.

#### NUMBER OF GUESTS / CHILD POLICY

'Enchanté' is ideally suited for couples, individuals or chartering parties of eight persons. There is special pricing for less-than-capacity chartering parties of six or seven persons. Children over 12 are welcome on hotel sailings; children under 12 are welcome on charters.

#### MEALS DURING THE CRUISE

Gourmet dining is an integral part of the 'Enchanté' experience and includes menus inspired by the renowned cuisine of France, featuring complementary wines and cheeses. Each morning the on-board chef heads to the local markets to gather fresh ingredients used in preparing the day's meals; on occasion, guests may accompany the chef and watch the chef prepare meals in the "demonstration" kitchen on board.

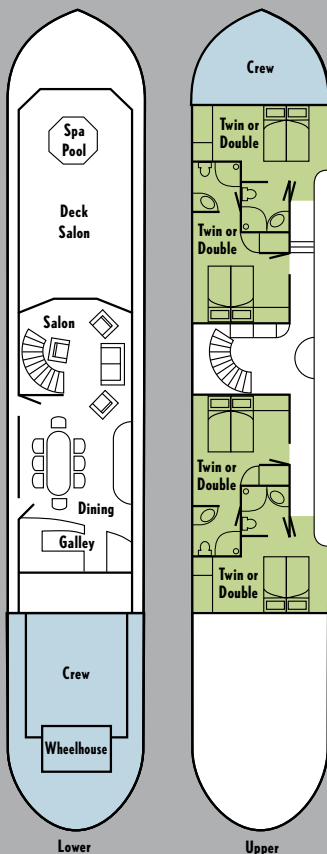
Breakfasts and lunches are served buffet style, and dinner is a set menu. Guests with specific food or dietary requests can generally be accommodated with advance notice. Weather permitting, there is also the possibility of *al fresco* meal service on the outdoor sun deck.



## CRUISE PRICE INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The cruise price includes on-board accommodations for six nights; all meals from dinner on day of embarkation through breakfast on day of disembarkation; all alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages on board; fully guided sightseeing excursions (as indicated on the day-by-day itinerary), including entrance fees; and transfers between Narbonne and the barge embarkation/disembarkation points.

The cruise price does NOT include gratuities to crew, travel insurance or airfare.



## BARGE SPECIFICS

- Four crew members, including an on-board chef
- Barge is 100 feet long, 16.5 feet wide and has air conditioning and central heating
- Salon and dining area approximately 390 square feet and features a stereo system with an assortment of CDs and a computer with Internet connection
- Exterior sun deck offers an additional 250 square feet of living space, partially covered by a parasol for *al fresco* dining, and features a Dimension One hot tub that can accommodate 7 or 8 persons
- Barge is not handicap accessible and is appropriate for those with only minor mobility issues
- Eight touring bicycles provided for guests' use
- Strict non-smoking policy in force in all interior areas
- No telephone access for guests on board but ample opportunities ashore
- Euros only form of payment accepted on board
