CRUISE ITINERARIES

From March through mid-May, 'Marjorie II' cruises in Holland and Belgium when spectacular spring flowers are in full bloom on a route that is half canal and half river. She then settles on the River Meuse in southern Belgium on an all-river route that includes visits to castles, friendly riverside towns and the famous Waterloo Battlefield.

Themed itineraries (such as golf) can be arranged for chartering parties with special interests.

All cruises are from Sunday through Saturday (six nights), with longer options available for chartering parties.

ON-BOARD ACCOMMODATIONS

The six cabins on board 'Marjorie II' are each 172 square feet in size and each includes an en suite bathroom. Beds can be made up as either two twins or one double. Each cabin features satellite television/VCR. Electrical current is 220V (standard European). A selection of toiletries, one robe per guest and a hairdryer are also provided.

NUMBER OF GUESTS / CHILD POLICY

'Marjorie II' is best suited for couples, individuals or chartering parties of 12 guests. There is special pricing for less-than-capacity chartering parties of 8, 9 or 10 guests. There is also special charter pricing for families with children under 16 on midsummer departures. Children over 14 are welcome on hotel sailings; children under 14 are welcome on charters.

MEALS DURING THE CRUISE

Gourmet dining is an integral part of the 'Marjorie II' experience. Menus are created to capture the local culinary traditions, and meals are prepared using the freshest ingredients from local markets; on occasion, guests can accompany the on-board chef to market in the morning. The wines and cheeses served on board are specially selected to enhance the dining experience of guests.

Breakfast and lunch are served buffet, and dinner is offered with a set menu. Guests with specific food or dietary requirements can generally be accommodated with advance notice. Weather permitting, there is also the possibility of *al fresco* meal service on the outdoor sun deck.

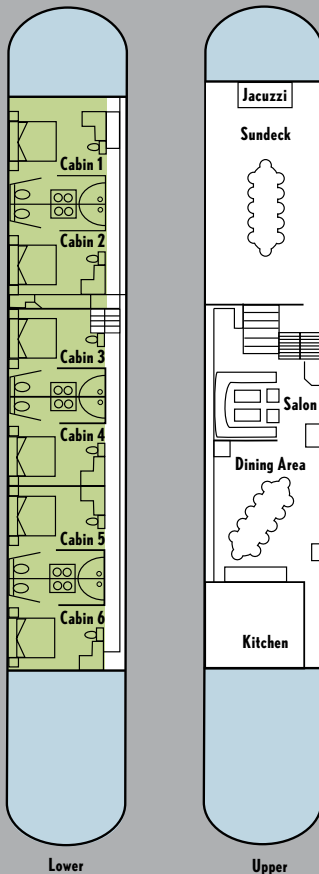


CRUISE PRICE INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The cruise price includes on-board accommodations for six nights; all meals from dinner on day of embarkation through breakfast on day of disembarkation; all alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages on board; fully guided sightseeing excursions (as indicated on the day-by-day itinerary), including entrance fees; and transfers between

Amsterdam, Bruges or Brussels (depending on itinerary) and the barge embarkation/disembarkation points.

The cruise price does NOT include gratuities to crew, travel insurance or airfare.



BARGE SPECIFICS

- Owned and operated by Ronny Muyshondt, a fifth-generation "barger"
- In addition to Captain Ronny, 'Marjorie II' is staffed by a crew of four to five, including an on-board chef
- Barge is 129 feet long, 16.5 feet wide, with air conditioning and central heating
- Salon/dining area offers almost 600 square feet of living space and features satellite TV/VCR with a selection of videos, a laptop for guests' use (nominal charges may apply)
- Sun deck offers 375 square feet of living space, includes a spa pool and is partially shaded by parasols for *al fresco* dining
- Barge is not handicap accessible and is appropriate for those with only minor mobility issues
- Mountain bicycles available for guests' use
- Strict non-smoking policy in force for all interior areas of the barge
- No telephone access on board but ample opportunities ashore
- Euros/€ only form of payment accepted on board
