CRUISE ITINERARIES

'Napoléon' cruises in the Vallée du Rhône in southern France, a route that is 100% river. Itineraries with special themes can be arranged for chartering parties with special interests.

All cruises are from Sunday through Saturday (six nights), with longer chartering options available.

ON-BOARD ACCOMMODATIONS

The one upper deck cabin and five lower-deck cabins can be configured as either queen or twins. En suite bathrooms feature a shower, toilet and pedestal basin, with shower gel, body cream, hand soap, shampoo and a hairdryer provided. 'Napoléon' cabins also offer a phone/intercom system so that guests may communicate directly with crew members in the galley or salon. Electrical current is 220V (standard European).

NUMBER OF GUESTS

'Napoléon' is best suited for couples, individuals or chartering parties of 12 persons. There is special pricing for for less-than-capacity chartering parties of eight to 11 persons. Children over 12 are welcome on hotel sailings; children under 12 are welcome on charters.

MEALS DURING THE CRUISE

Gourmet dining is an integral part of the 'Napoléon' experience. Menus are inspired by the culinary traditions for which France is known, and meals are prepared using the freshest ingredients from local markets; on occasion, interested guests may accompany the chef to the market. The wines and cheeses served on board are specially selected to enhance the dining experience.

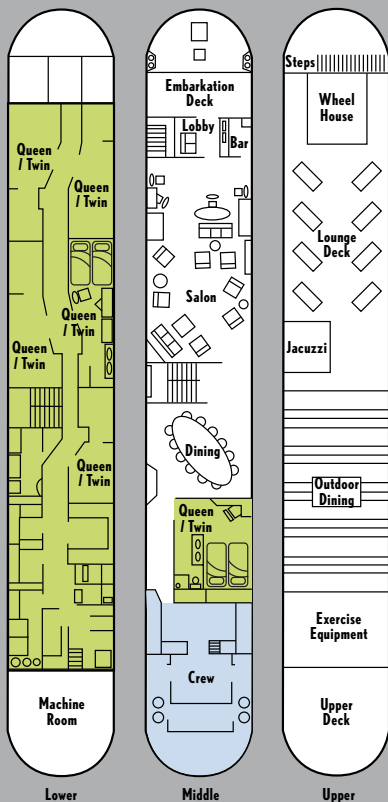
Breakfast and lunch are served buffet style, while a set menu is offered at dinner. Guests with specific food requests can generally be accommodated with advance notice. Weather permitting, there is also the possibility of *al fresco* meal service on the outdoor sun decks.



CRUISE PRICE INCLUSIONS & EXCLUSIONS

The cruise price includes on-board accommodations for six nights; all meals from dinner on day of embarkation through breakfast on day of disembarkation; all alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages on board; fully-guided sightseeing excursions (as indicated on the day-by-day itinerary), including entrance fees; and transfers between Paris and the barge embarkation/disembarkation points.

The cruise price does NOT include gratuities to crew, travel insurance or airfare.



BARGE SPECIFICS

- Staffed by 6-7 crew members, including an on-board chef
- Barge is 129 feet long, 16.5 feet wide and has air conditioning and central heating
- On-board living space includes a salon with separate dining area and features a television and stereo system with an assortment of DVDs and CDs for guests' use
- Barge not handicap accessible and is appropriate for those with only minor mobility issues
- Twelve mountain bicycles available for guests' use
- Strict non-smoking policy in effect on all interior areas of the barge
- No guest telephone access on board but ample opportunities ashore
- Euros only form of payment accepted on board
